- Please take of the park by cleaning up following your reservation, and refrain from damaging the surface of the shelters with glue, nails, tacks or fasteners.
- Hood River Valley Parks and Recreation District facilities are tobacco, alcohol, and substance free.
- Self-contained barbecues that are a minimum of 6" off the ground are allowed. The permittee is responsible for the safe disposal of the coals and/or grease off-site.
- Please pack your trash out.
- If you need to cancel your reservation, please call 541-386-5720 at least 48 hours before your reservation in order to receive a refund.
- Payment must be received in order to confirm reservation. Checks may be made to Hood River Valley Parks and Recreation District (HRVPRD), or payments can be made via credit card by calling 541-386-5720.
- Our facilities are first come, first served. If you wish to reserve a facility for exclusive use (court or pump track), please use the facility use agreement for reserving multiple items at one time.
